

## DINGHY EVENTS

**It is the sole responsibility of the skipper of each craft to decide whether to participate in club events.**

Adequate personal buoyancy must be worn at all times. All craft taking part in club events **MUST** have adequate third party insurance. Event organisers are not liable for loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused, to participants as a result of their taking part in club events.

Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his/her craft for the event.

**Dinghy events must not take place without a designated Officer Of The Day on duty.**

## SUPPORT BOATS

The coxswain must hold an RYA Safety Boat Certificate. The support boats must not be coxed unaccompanied. The coxswain is responsible for the preparation of the craft and for its operation.

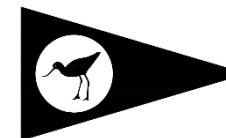
## CRUISING EVENTS
